- Entries must be 9" x 12" using construction paper or poster board.
- Entries must be drawn freehand using pen, pencil, crayon, paint, or any combination of these media. A straight edge may also be used to aid in drawing a straight line.
- The student's description of the poster must be written on the back of the poster in 50 words or less. Descriptions that are attached to the back of the poster will also be accepted.

ESSAY/POEM GUIDELINES

- All Stories/poems may be written in blue ink, typed, or produced on a computer.
- All students must address the theme (theme changes annually, see enclosed flyer or contact you local AMVETS post).
- Essays submitted by 6th through 8th grade students must be 250 words or less; 9th through 12th grade students must be 350 words or less.
