## Wisconsin AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary Health Care Scholarship Rules

(Revised 2016)

- **a)** The applicant must meet the requirements for admission as a full time student to an accredited college or university, or have current enrollment as a Freshman or Sophomore, pursuing an Associate's Degree, Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or Doctorate Degree in a health care related program are eligible to apply.
  - **b)** The applicant must be the child, grandchild, sister or brother of an AMVET or AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary member, or the child, grandchild, sister or brother of a deceased Veteran who would have been eligible to join AMVETS.
- 2. Any applicant who has previously received an AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary scholarship will be ineligible.
- 3. Upon award of the scholarship, the applicant must be prepared to enter college no later than the earliest term following high school graduation or be a current college Freshman or Sophomore. Failure to begin attending at the earliest term following high school graduation will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship.
- 4. One scholarship will be given in the amount of \$1200.00. Additional scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the committee chairman. The number of scholarships and their amounts will be determined prior to judging of the applications.
- **5.** The following must be submitted to the sponsoring AMVETS Auxiliary:
  - a. Proof of acceptance to an accredited college or university or proof of current enrollment.
  - b. Transcript of grades.
  - c. Character and scholastic reference letters (2).
  - d. Two personal references in writing (such as employer, clergyman or person other than relative).
  - e. Short resume stating specific field chosen and why it was chosen.
- 6. The sponsoring Auxiliary shall submit all items in #5, along with the current application blank or a completed copy thereof to the Department Scholarship Chairman. Failure to do this would mean disqualification.
- 7. There shall be (3) impartial, non-AMVETS or AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary connected judges who are affiliated with the medical profession. These judges will be selected by the Department Scholarship Chairman.
- **8.** Each applicant will be numbered by the Department Scholarship Chairman and submitted to the judges.
- **9.** Judging will be based on letters, qualifications and eligibility.
- **10.** The entries must be in the hands of the sponsoring Auxiliary on/or before April 1st and received by the Department Scholarship Chairman no later than April 15<sup>th</sup>. The winner will be notified by April 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 11. The final decision will be made by the judges and shall be binding on all parties.
- **12.** A local Auxiliary sponsoring a winner will be notified by May 15<sup>th</sup>.
- **13**. The recipient(s) shall be notified prior to the end of the current school year and will be invited to attend the Department AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary Awards Luncheon in June.
